

Allotment Society of Crossways

Helping the Community grow

The Allotment Society was officially started on the 8th November 2008 and is administered by a small Committee working in conjunction with the Crossways Parish Council. We have established an Allotment site on the West Stafford Road with room for 44 plots comprising of three sizes- full plots of 30m x 8m, medium plots of 14.5m x 8m and small plots of 8m x 7m.



All the 44 plots will be allocated shortly and there is a small waiting list, so we are still looking for land as we know the list will continue to grow.

There is a one-off £5 registration fee with an annual membership fee of £5. This gives allotment holders insurance cover for their plot and access to discounted seeds, sheds and much

more. The maximum annual rental for the plots will be no more than £27. Once the Tenancy agreement has been signed and fees paid a plot will be allocated, the Allotment holder will be given a key to the site and a Car Park Permit for the Allotment Car Park.

The ASC, as we refer to ourselves, is a group of very friendly and enthusiastic people with many levels of knowledge about growing but we all have a common interest and are very supportive of one another. On the allotment site don't be surprised to see folks of all ages, ranging from 3 year olds, helping their parents, to 90; all enjoying the shared activity and community feeling. We will be organising events throughout the year ahead and these will be posted here for folks to see.
