

**MINUTES OF THE CROSSWAYS PARISH COUNCIL FULL COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON  
THURSDAY 26<sup>TH</sup> OCTOBER 2006 AT 7PM IN THE VILLAGE HALL**

**PUBLIC INFORMATION ANNOUNCEMENTS** None to report.

**PUBLIC PARTICIPATION** None requested by members of the public present. Cllr Brewer asked those members of the Community Association present if they would like to make a report. This was declined.

**REPORT BY COMMUNITY POLICE OFFICER** No Police Officer or Community Support Officer present.

**REPORTS BY DISTRICT AND COUNTY COUNCILLORS** Apologies were received from District Councillor Smy. County Councillor Crowhurst was not present. District Councillor Teresa Seall's report is attached to the main and library copy of these minutes. In addition to her written report Cllr Seall reported on planning applications pertaining to Crossways heard earlier in the day. Cllr Seall reported that the Hybris application by Colortec had been granted with eight stringent conditions. Cllr Seall also reported that the application to change a detached property into 2 semi detached properties submitted by Betterment Properties had also been approved. Cllr Chubb questioned whether further applications of this nature would be permitted. Cllr Seall stated each case would be judged on its merits. Cllr Peacocke asked if other spray painting operations being undertaken at Hybris would be subject to such monitoring as the Colortec business. It was noted that any concerns regarding any spray painting operations should be submitted to Environmental Health.

Cllr Brewer thanked Cllr Stenning for her attendance at the recent CAEA meeting and her efforts to question anomalies in the minutes. Cllr Brewer asked, that in view of the planning difficulties being experienced in the Church application, the Council consider opening negotiations for a three way working party to look into bringing a Church/Community Centre to the site of the Youth Club.

Council was suspended to hear from Reverend Jacque Birdseye.

Councillors agreed to seek agreement from DCC to release the land. The Clerk was requested to write to DCC on this matter referring to the Section 106 agreement for the Woodsford Fields Development.
